

Acceptance of School Policies

1. I understand that it is my responsibility to read the Treeside Charter School Policy Manual. Which can also be found at www.treesidecharterschool.org
2. I understand that all medication that is to be given at school must be furnished by me or another guardian and delivered to the school by a responsible adult, with proper required documentation signed by parent and prescribing professional.
3. I will promote the mission of the school by being courteous and respectful when interacting with staff, students, parents, and anyone else in the school community. I agree to take any concerns I have directly to the person most able to successfully address those concerns, and not to others who cannot address the concern. I will work in a cooperative manner to promote the school mission.
4. I understand that a student may be denied an open enrollment opportunity if the student has been suspended or expelled from a public school. A student with prior behavioral problems may be granted provisional enrollment provided the student and parent sign an agreement with the school (1) establishing the conditions of continued enrollment and (2) notify the parents/student that the student will be excluded from the school if the agreement is violated. The school is responsible for the agreement. Please refer to Utah Code, Sections 53A-2-208 (3)(b)(c). 53G-8-204.
5. I understand that my child will be required to follow the school dress code. I have read and understand the school dress code policy and will insure that my child is in compliance with the school dress code policy. <https://treesidecharterschool.org/dress-code>
6. I understand that part of the schools' mission is the help my child gain knowledge and a love of learning. I will support this effort by providing a place and a regular time each school day in which my child can engage in learning activities in our home.
7. I understand the school will provide a lunch program and that my child can bring a snack and a lunch to school each day or order lunch through the school lunch program. I understand that the school will not turn my child away if they ask for a lunch and I am responsible for covering the cost of the lunch provided.
8. I understand the school will not, with designated route exceptions, provide transportation to and from school and that I am responsible for making sure that my child is safely dropped off and picked up each school day, within 15 minutes of the end of school or I will call the office.
9. I understand the school has a goal of 95% attendance for students. I will work to schedule outside appointments during times that do not conflict with school hours. I will bring my student to school on time. I understand that if my child is absent 10 consecutive school days he/she may be unenrolled from the school, according to school guidelines.
